## President's Corner—Summer Update

The last of the good riding on The Hill was toward the end of March...5 months and 55 degrees ago! Here's a quick update on what the Club has been up to all summer:

At the Annual Meeting in April, the results of the elections for Board members were as follows: Fred Spicer, Seth Holder and Gary Lazaroff, Jr. **Congratulations!** The membership also approved the purchase of a groomer (more on that below).

In May we held a short Club meeting and held our first work detail of the year. We had a super turnout with approximately 22 volunteers! Regular trail clean up was started, brushing was done on Camp 2 and Pisten Bully #5 was detailed.

At the Club meeting in June, a vacancy on the Board of Directors was filled. The Board appointed Doug Nichols to the position—Congratulations Doug and welcome to the Board! Several fundraising ideas were discussed, a new raffle was proposed while the Dash for Cash (included with this issue) was finalized.

During the work days in June, It poured the day of our meeting, so summer maintenance was started on groomer #7 instead. Oil samples were taken, tracks removed, bolts tightened, etc.

Now for the good news! **We listened** to the many requests from our members over the past several years regarding the reopening of the Camp 2 Trail. **We promised** that if there was a way to reopen it, we would find it...and this year **We delivered!!** In the previous newsletter, we outlined the 4 Phase process to accomplish this goal:

**Phase I** 2009 Dash for Cash Raffle to raise groomer down payment money

**Phase II** hold additional fundraisers to allow upgrades to our groomer fleet which will accommodate the additional grooming requirements the Camp 2 trail will demand

**Phase III** Camp 2 Maintenance

**Phase IV** groomer purchase and equipment upgrades

After much research, we purchased the Pisten Bully with drag from the Barnes Corners Sno Pals!! Yes, the one with the new motor installed the first of the year! With this purchase, we are happy to announce that the Camp 2 Trail will be open for the upcoming snowmobile season. There still is much work to be done and **Now we need your continued support** to help us maintain trails and raise funds to offset costs associated with our \$75,000 groomer loan.

The new membership application is also enclosed. Feel free to copy and give to your riding partners or download one online. Your registration renewals will soon be in the mail, so you will need your membership vouchers.

The Club newsletter is getting ready to go digital. For the next issue, we will email you a link to download it from the website. This will save us a tremendous amount every year in postage.
